Medicare prescription drug plans and standalone prescription drug plans will provide most Humana-covered Part D vaccines (including shingles) at no cost, no matter what cost-sharing tier it's on, even if the plan has a deductible that has not been paid.

Members won't pay more than \$35 for a one-month (up to 30-day) supply of each Part D insulin product covered by our plan, no matter what cost-sharing tier it's on, even if they haven't paid their deductible.

Prescription Drug Plans



Our prescription drug plans assist members with more access to medications at affordable prices than Original Medicare. That could translate to fewer hurdles and more adherence. As a reminder, marketing or communicating 2024 plan information prior to October 1 is strictly prohibited.

Expanded retail pharmacy networks with preferred cost sharing at in-network pharmacies, like Albertsons Companies family of pharmacies, Walmart, Walmart Neighborhood Markets, Sam's Club (no membership required), Publix, CenterWell, H-E-B and Costco, mean more access at better prices. These plans could be a great fit for Original Medicare beneficiaries, even those enrolled in a MedSupp plan.
